Why is it important to PLAN?

- Easily enroll in the classes you want to take
 - *YOU are in charge of enrolling in your classes!!*
- Ensure you take all required classes to graduate
- Balance the number of units you have each semester
- Save money
 - Avoid late registration (and possible late fees?)
 - Take the classes you need in a timely manner
 - Avoid having to stay longer to take classes you need

Assist.org

You can enter the university you plan to transfer to and the CC you're transferring from, and it will give you a list of courses that you can/will take at the CC before you transfer!

While the list may not be current, it can give you an idea of what you will need to take to prep for your major.

Your Task (Part 1)

1. Choose a college for which to plan your 4 years
 - a. *This can be the college you plan to go to OR, if you don't know yet, one you have applied to*
2. Go to the college's website and search for "Course Catalog"
3. Find Baccalaureate Degree Requirements (or General Education requirements)
4. Read through the requirements and take notes
5. Turn notes in when finished
