

Francis Scott Key Fitzgerald

- Does his name sound familiar??
 Second cousin of Francis Scott Key
- Born in 1896 in Minnesota
- Irish-Catholic upbringing
- Father = salesman for Procter & Gamble
- Moved to NY for father's job (Buffalo and Syracuse), then back to MN after father lost job in 1908

- Attended Princeton University
- Honed craft as a writer; wrote scripts for musicals, stories for Nassau Literary Magazine, and articles for humor magazine The Princeton Tiger
- Dropped out in 1917 (academic probation)
- Joined the US Army

- Married Zelda Sayre in 1920
 Zelda = from high-class family
- One daughter, Frances Scott Fitzgerald
- Led extravagant lifestyle
- Wrote short stories/novels to support lifestyle
- "It was an age of miracles... It was an age of art, it was an age of excess, and it was an age of satire."

Major Works

- This Side of Paradise 1920
 Roughly autobiographical story about
 - himself and Zelda
- The Beautiful and the Damned 1922
 Helped cement his status as a chronicler of the extravagance of the decade
- The Great Gatsby 1924
 - Written in France; considered Fitzgerald's finest work

Final Years

- Progressed into alcoholism after Gatsby was completed
- Zelda suffered mental health issues and breakdowns
- Died in 1940; age 44
- Posthumously successful
